# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to reinstatement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Section 8(2)(b) of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the last sentence in lines 103, 104 and 105 and

3 inserting in place thereof the following: "Such member shall be required to pay into the annuity

4 savings fund an amount such member would have paid had he continued working, plus interest."
