An Act relative to the sales tax..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (h) of section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the
3 following sentence:- “Food products” does not include limited nutritional items sold in all retail
4 stores.

5 SECTION 2. Said chapter 64H is hereby further amended by inserting after section 6 the
6 following section:-

7 Section 6A. Under the provisions of this chapter, a sales tax shall be imposed on the sale
8 in any retail store of any food product that has limited nutritional value.
