An Act relative to motor vehicle excise tax exemptions..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 60A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2009  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the first sentence of the fifth paragraph in line 44  
3 and inserting in place thereof the following:-

4           “The excise imposed by this section shall not apply to motor vehicles or trailers owned  
5 and registered by the commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof, or to motor vehicles or  
6 trailers owned and registered by a corporation whose personal property is exempt from taxation  
7 under clauses Third and Tenth of section five of chapter fifty-nine, provided that the vehicle is  
8 operated exclusively in connection with the organization's tax exempt operations.”
