An Act designating a certain traffic island in the town of Hingham as the Sergeant Boris Demko Memorial Island.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. The traffic island at the intersection of Route 3A and Beal Street in Hingham  
2 shall be designated and known as the Sergeant Boris Demko Memorial island, in honor of United  
3 States Air Force Sergeant Demko who was killed in action during World War II. The  
4 Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing  
5 that designation in compliance with the standards of the department.

6           Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
