The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to gun safe deductions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of Part B of section 3 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as
most recently amended by section 62 of chapter 68 of the acts of 2011, is hereby further
amended by adding the following subparagraph:-

4 (17) The amount equal to the amount of a purchase of a gun safe; provided however, that 5 such deduction shall not exceed \$2,000 for a single person, for a married person filing a separate 6 return of a head of household, or a married couple filing a joint return.
