An Act relative to agricultural school transportation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 8A of chapter 74 is hereby amended by adding the following:-  
2 ;provided, however, that this section shall not apply to persons who are enrolled in an  
3 agricultural school under this chapter. Transportation for a person enrolled in an agricultural  
4 school shall be funded by the parents of the student, the student, or the legal guardians of the  
5 student.
