By Representative McMurtry of Dedham and Senator Rush, a joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3794) of Paul McMurtry and Michael F. Rush (by vote of the town) for legislation to exempt the police department of the town of Westwood from the provisions of civil service law. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act exempting the Police Department of the Town of Westwood from the provisions of the Civil Service Law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1: The police department in the Town of Westwood shall be exempt from the provisions of Chapter 31 of the General Laws.
- Section 2: The provisions of Section 1 of this act shall not impair the Civil

  Service status of the present incumbent uniformed Police Department personnel holding such status on the effective date of this act.
- 6 Section 3: This act shall take effect upon its passage.
