An Act relative to split-screen technology.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 13 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws as so appearing in the 2012 Official  
2 Edition of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking in lines 28-30 the words: “which is  
3 located in the motor vehicle at any point forward of the back of the driver’s seat, or which is  
4 visible to the driver while operating such motor vehicle” and inserting in place thereof the  
5 following words “unless the equipment is so configured that the television broadcast or other  
6 video images are not in view of the operator of the vehicle while the motor vehicle is in motion”
