Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. The eleventh paragraph of section 8 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-

An applicant for the renewal of a license, who is required to have a new photograph appear on the license upon renewal, may be granted a 1 year extension of the use of the applicant's current photograph if the applicant presents documentation by a licensed physician that the applicant has undergone medical treatment resulting in temporarily changes to the physical characteristics of the licensee as a result of illness; provided, however, that the licensee shall be responsible for obtaining a new photograph within 1 year of the extension.
