An Act relative to private roads in the town of Barnstable.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 174 of the acts of 1994 is hereby amended by striking out the first  
2 sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- Notwithstanding the provisions  
3 of any general or special law to the contrary, the town of Barnstable is hereby authorized to  
4 borrow from time to time as authorized by a two-thirds vote of the town council such sums as  
5 may be necessary for the purpose of repairing and improving private ways within the town;  
6 provided, however, that the outstanding indebtedness pursuant to this act shall not exceed  
7 \$15,000,000 at the close of any fiscal year.

8           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
