## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen  
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An Act to enhance the management of problem wildlife..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 80A of Chapter 131 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof, the following new paragraph: -

3           Any person issued a permit as provided by this section shall, within thirty days of the  
4 expiration of such permit or extension of same shall report to the director of the division of  
5 fisheries and wildlife, on a form approved by said director, the municipality of which the request  
6 was made, the name of the property owner, address of the property threatened, the name of  
7 authorized agent, method used to alleviate the problem, and the number and species of animals  
8 taken pursuant to the permit, and other information deemed necessary by the director.
