Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. The second sentence of section 13 of chapter 94 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the word

- "precluded", the following words: -; and provided further, the provisions of this chapter shall be
- 4 inapplicable to the owner, or any person owning a share of a cow or goat, who is using any
- 5 product derived from such animal for personal consumption.
