An Act restricting medical prescriptions filing personnel.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Chapter 94C of the General  
2       Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting after Section 9(d)  
3       the following sentence:-

4           The persons authorized to file prescription records is restricted to physicians, physicians  
5       assistants, dentists, podiatrists, certified nurse midwives, nurse practitioners, psychiatric nurse  
6       mental health clinical specialists, nurse anesthetists, pharmacists, chiropractor, and veterinarians.
