An Act relative to medical examinations in correctional facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section sixteen of chapter 127 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:— During the  
3 conduct of any such physical examination or any subsequent medical examination of a female  
4 inmate, the presence of a female nurse or female corrections officer shall be required. Nothing in  
5 this section shall prohibit the rendering of immediate emergency medical treatment for a  
6 potentially life-threatening condition.
