An Act relative to hoisting in-service training programs and short-term rental entities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following section:

3           Section 65B. The commissioner shall have the authority to charge an application fee  
4 from persons or entities seeking approval to operate an in-service training program under section  
5 53 and from persons or entities seeking approval to operate as short-term rental entities from  
6 which compact hoisting machinery is to be rented on a temporary basis under section 65A.
