An Act relative to the reinstatement of certain beneficiaries for accidental death retirement benefits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Boston  
2 Retirement Board shall reinstate accidental death benefits to Edith Carell, the surviving former  
3 spouse of Michael A. Carell, under the provisions of sections 9 and 94 of chapter 32 of the  
4 General Laws.
