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In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen
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An Act increasing restaurant competitiveness.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “except”, in line 5, the
3 following words:-

4 the excise imposed on upon the sale of restaurant meals at the rate of 5 per cent and

5 SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 64L of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
6 amended by striking “.75 per cent”, in line 4, and inserting in place thereof the following:- “1 per
7 cent”.
