An Act regarding the human resources division.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 4A of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out subsection (b) in its entirety.

3           SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any duty, task  
4 or responsibility formerly under the purview of the personnel administrator shall reside with the  
5 secretary of the executive office for administration and finance, including, but not limited to  
6 those responsibilities identified in section 41 of chapter 6C, sections 28, and 28A of chapter 7,  
7 sections 45, 46, 46I, 49, and 53 of chapter 30, sections 47A and 61A of chapter 31, and section 5  
8 of chapter 32 of the General Laws.
