*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 10 of Chapter 25A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended in subsection (b) by inserting after the words “in adoption of demand
- 3 side reduction initiatives” in lines 18-19 the following words:-
- 4 all or a portion of the salaries of municipal or regional energy managers;
