*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                    Chapter 2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following new section:-

3                    Section 61. The sport of volleyball shall be the official recreational and team  
4 sport of the commonwealth.
