An Act relative to tobacco cessation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1            SECTION\_\_\_. Section 7 of chapter 270 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end the following new paragraph:-

3            The owner or other person in charge of a shop or other place used to sell any tobacco  
4 products at retail shall conspicuously post signage provided by the Department of Public Health  
5 that discloses current referral information about smoking cessation which may include but not be  
6 limited to the website of the Massachusetts Tobacco Cessation & Prevention Program  
7 (www.makesmokinghistory.org) and The Smokers Helpline at 1-800-Quit-Now (1-800-784-  
8 8669).
