By Mr. Pacheco, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Marc R. Pacheco, Patricia A. Haddad and Keiko M. Orrall for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for John Gallagher, an employee of the Department of Youth Services. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen
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An Act establishing a sick leave bank for John Gallagher, an employee of the Department of Youth Services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department
2 of youth services shall establish a sick leave bank for John Gallagher, an employee of the
3 department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal
4 or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by John Gallagher. Whenever John Gallagher
5 terminates employment with the office or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining
6 time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave
7 bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the
8 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
