## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act establishing Ataxia Awareness Day.

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Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 15RRRRR the following section:-

Section 15SSSSS. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart September 25 as Ataxia Awareness Day, in recognition of the thousands of individuals affected by hereditary and sporadic ataxia in the United States and the need for increased public awareness, research, prevention and support for victims and their families and recommending that the day be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
