Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 92 of chapter 276 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

Any order of restitution in a criminal case that has not been satisfied or revoked, whether or not originally imposed as a condition of probation, shall in the court's discretion be separately enforceable pursuant to section 1 of chapter 279 even after the defendant has been discharged

6 from probation or after the defendant's probation has been revoked and the defendant committed.
