An Act relative to the certification of assessors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "years," in line 12, the
following:- who shall be state-certified or state-licensed as defined by section 174 of chapter
112.

5 SECTION 2. Section 24 of said chapter 41, as so appearing, is hereby amended by 6 inserting after the word "law" in line 4, the following:- and shall be state-certified or state-7 licensed as defined by section 174 of chapter 112.

8 SECTION 3. Said section 24 of said chapter 41, as so appearing, is hereby further 9 amended by inserting at the end thereof the following sentence:- No assessor may assess 10 property in any city or town in which they own property.
