The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act authorizing the rent board of the town of Middleborough to impose fees for the employment of outside consultants.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule, regulation or by-law to
2 the contrary, the rent board of the town of Middleborough may provide by rules for the
3 imposition of reasonable fees for the employment of outside consultants in connection with such
4 town's review of petitions for rent adjustments under the town's rules and regulations for mobile
5 home park accommodations, rents and evictions and shall account for and expend such funds
6 under section 53G of chapter 44 of the General Laws.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
