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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen  
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An Act designating Conflict Resolution Awareness Week.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith the third week in October as “Conflict Resolution Awareness Week,” , therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1            Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after  
2            section 15UUUU, as amended by chapter 175 of the acts of 2014 the following section:-

3            Section 15VVVV. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the  
4            third week in October as “Conflict Resolution Awareness Week,” to raise public awareness of  
5            mediation and conflict resolution practices
