**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to ordinary disability retirements.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (2) of section 6 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following new paragraph:-

3 (e) Upon acceptance of this paragraph by a retirement system, payments to a member
4 retired under the provisions of this section shall be no less than the monthly payment to a
5 disabled individual, with the same marital status and living situation, under the state
6 supplemental security income program. Acceptance of this paragraph shall be by a majority vote
7 of the board of each such system, subject to the approval of the legislative body. For the
8 purposes herein, “legislative body” shall mean, in the case of a city, the city council in
9 accordance with its charter, in the case of a town, the board of selectmen, in the case of a county,
10 the county retirement board advisory council, in the case of a region, the regional retirement

11 board advisory council, in the case of a district, the district members, and, in the case of an
12 authority, the governing body. Acceptance shall be deemed to have occurred upon the filing of a
13 certification of such votes with the commission. For purposes herein, the state teachers' and
14 state employees' retirement systems shall be deemed to have accepted this paragraph.
