An Act defining performed services for correctional officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 28N of Chapter 32 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2006 Official edition  
2 is hereby amended by adding the following:

3           "For purposes of this provision, the term "performed services" shall be deemed to include  
4 any period during which the employee was employed but unable to work due a work related  
5 injury compensable under Chapter 152"
