An Act to make provisional employees in the labor service permanent employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 31 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended by  
2     inserting after Section 28 the following:—

3           Section 28A. All employees employed by the Commonwealth and by cities, towns, and  
4     districts, in the Commonwealth in a labor service position for two years or more shall be made  
5     permanent employees. The Personnel Administration shall annually report to the General Court  
6     the number of labor service employees made permanent.
