An Act Relative to Corporate Minimum Tax Exemption.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of Section 2 of chapter 63 of the General Laws, as appearing
2	in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 15 through 17, the clause
3	"; provided, however, that the excise imposed hereunder shall be no less than four hundred and
4	fifty-six dollars.".
5	SECTION 2. Subsection (b) of Section 2 of said chapter 63, as so appearing, is hereby
5	SECTION 2. Subsection (b) of Section 2 of said chapter 05, as so appearing, is hereby
6	further amended by striking out, in lines 25 through 27, the clause "; provided, however, that in
7	no case shall the excise imposed under this section amount to less than \$456.".
8	SECTION 3. Section 38B of said chapter 63, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
9	striking out, in lines 12 through 13, and in lines 25 through 26, the clause "or four hundred and
10	fifty-six dollars, whichever is greater.
