Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 268A, Section 6B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 official edition,
2 is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following:-

3 All disclosures made pursuant to this section shall be filed on a separate page at the end
4 of each application in order to facilitate accessibility for public inspection.
