3           Section 115A of Chapter 164 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2012 Official  
4           Edition is hereby amended by striking out, in line 2, the word “seven” and inserting in place  
5           thereof the following word:- fifteen.

6           Section 115A of Chapter 164 of the general laws, as so appearing, is hereby further  
7           amended by adding, in the first paragraph after the words “in accordance with law”, the  
8           following:- ; provided however, that a gas company or municipal lighting plant may petition the  
9           department for approval of an alternate gas meter replacement plan and the department may

- 10 approve such an alternate plan upon a determination that the plan is consistent with the public
- 11 interest.
