**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to veterans preference for public housing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 32 of chapter 121B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 Notwithstanding any general or special law or regulation to the contrary, a veteran’s
4 preference shall be given for all assisted housing in the Commonwealth over an applicant for
5 assisted housing under this chapter who is not eligible for federal assisted housing under 42
6 U.S.C. section 1436a shall not displace or be given priority over any applicant who is so eligible.
