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**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court

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An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Thomas J. Doucette, an employee of the Department of Correction.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Department of Corrections, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Department of Corrections  
2 shall establish a sick leave bank for Thomas J. Doucette an employee of the Department of  
3 Corrections. Any employee of the Department of Corrections may voluntarily contribute 1 or  
4 more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Thomas J. Doucette.  
5 Whenever Thomas J. Doucette terminates employment with the department or requests to  
6 dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the  
7 extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the  
8 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by  
9 the department.
