An Act relative to changing the name of the State-Boston Retirement System to the Boston Retirement System.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 120 and 138, the word “State-  
3 Boston” and inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the following word:- Boston.

4           SECTION 2. Section 2 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking  
5 out, in line 25, the word “State-Boston” and inserting in place thereof the following word:-  
6 Boston.

7           SECTION 3. Section 3 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking  
8 out, in line 208, the word “State-Boston” and inserting in place thereof the following word:-  
9 Boston.

10          SECTION 4. Section 4 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking  
11 out, in lines 74, 96, 162 and 177 the word “State-Boston” and inserting in place thereof, in each  
12 instance, the following word:- Boston.

13 SECTION 5. Section 5 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking  
14 out, in lines 296 and 297, line 300, 302, 307, lines 310 and 311 and in line 344, the word “State-  
15 Boston” and inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the following word:- Boston.

16 SECTION 6. Section 22 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended by  
17 striking out, in line 10, lines 808 and 809, lines 842, 847, 850 and 851, the word “State-Boston”  
18 and inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the following word:- Boston.

19 SECTION 7. Said section 22 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby further  
20 amended by striking out, in line 807, the word “State-Boston” and inserting in place thereof the  
21 following word:- Boston.

22 SECTION 8. Said section 22 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby further  
23 amended by striking out, in lines 848 and 849, the phrase “State-Boston retirement board” and  
24 inserting in place thereof the following words:- Boston retirement system.

25 SECTION 9. Section 23 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended by  
26 striking out, in lines 2 and 3, and in lines 12 and 15, the word “State-Boston” and inserting in  
27 place thereof, in each instance, the following word:- Boston.

28 SECTION 10. Section 91 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended by  
29 striking out, in lines 126, and in lines 131 and 132, the word “State-Boston” and inserting in  
30 place thereof, in each instance, the following word:- Boston.

31 SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the phrase  
32 “State-Boston retirement board” wherever it appears in a general or special law, shall mean the  
33 Boston retirement board.

34           SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the phrase  
35 “State-Boston retirement system” wherever it appears in a general or special law, shall mean the  
36 Boston retirement system.

37           SECTION 13. Any business formerly transacted under the names “State-Boston  
38 retirement system,” “State--Boston retirement system,” “State-Boston retirement board” and  
39 “Boston Retirement Board,” or any contracts entered into by the aforementioned, remains in full  
40 force and effect and is no way impacted by the administrative name change pursuant to this act.
