**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**

An Act declaring the first Monday of the month of May as school crossing guard day.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after Section  
2 15WWWW, inserted by chapter 294 of the acts of 2014, the following section:-

3 Section 15XXXXX. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the  
4 first Monday in May as School Crossing Guard Appreciation Day, in recognition of the  
5 important role that crossing guards play in keeping students safe as they head to and from school  
6 and recommending that the day be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
