An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Deborah Clay, an employee of the Trial Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the trial court shall establish a  
2 sick leave bank for Deborah Clay, an employee of the Framingham district court in the  
3 department of the trial court. Any employee of the trial court may voluntarily contribute 1 or  
4 more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Deborah Clay. Whenever  
5 Deborah Clay terminates employment with the court or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank,  
6 any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the trial court paid leave bank.  
7 Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that  
8 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the trial court.
