**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Eric Burton, an employee of the Suffolk County Sheriff's Department.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Suffolk County Sheriff's Department, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the
2 Suffolk County Sheriff's Department shall establish a sick leave bank for Eric Burton, an
3 employee of the sheriff's department. Any employee of the Suffolk county sheriff's department
4 may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick days to the sick leave bank for use by Eric Burton.
5 Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that
6 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the sheriff's department.
7 Whenever Eric Burton terminates employment with the sheriff's department or requests to
8 dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the
9 extended illness leave bank.
