**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Brian Sheehan, an employee of the Middlesex County Sheriff's Office.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Middlesex sheriff's office, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Middlesex sheriff's office
2 shall establish a sick leave bank for Brian Sheehan, an employee of the sheriff's office. Any
3 employee of the sheriff's office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation
4 days to the sick leave bank for use by Brian Sheehan. Whenever Brian Sheehan terminates
5 employment with the sheriff's office or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining
6 time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave
7 bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the
8 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the sheriff's office.
