**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to the taxation of cider.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 21 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 20 and 21, the words “six per cent of
3 alcohol by weight” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- 8 1/2 per cent alcohol by
4 volume.

5 SECTION 2. Said section 21 of said chapter 138, as so appearing, is hereby further
6 amended by striking out, in line 25, the word “six” and inserting in place thereof the following
7 figure:- 8 1/2.
