An Act relative to bow hunting for deer in Wompatuck State Park.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding section 7 of chapter 132A of the General Laws or any other law or rule  
2   to the contrary, the hunting of deer by bow and arrow in the Wompatuck State Park shall be  
3   permitted. The commissioner of the department of conservation and recreation may promulgate  
4   rules and regulations to provide for such hunting.
