An Act relative to increasing the hours of employment of pensioners for services after retirement in the public sector.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (b) of section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking the words “nine hundred and sixty hours” and inserting the following  
3 words:- fifteen hundred hours

4           SECTION 2. Subsection (c) of said section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is  
5 hereby amended by striking the words “nine hundred and sixty” and inserting the following  
6 words:- fifteen hundred.
