**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Jodi Paris Anastos, an employee of the Operational Services Division.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the executive office of health
2 and human services shall establish a sick leave bank for Jodi Paris Anastos, an employee of the
3 office. Any employee of the office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or
4 vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Jodi Paris Anastos to care for her mother. When
5 Jodi Paris Anastos terminates employment with the office or requests to dissolve the sick leave
6 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave
7 bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability
8 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the office.
