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**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**  
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An Act relative to adolescent development.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The Executive Office of Health and Human Services is hereby directed to  
2   develop a plan to identify and treat adolescents at risk of committing mass violence. This plan  
3   should emphasize individuals' risk profile, not the presence or absence of mental illness. The  
4   plan should build on the Report on Patient and Staff Safety completed in 2011, but also consider  
5   additional sources of information in order to address the challenges presented by all young  
6   people, whether or not they have been diagnosed with mental illness.
