An Act relative to change of address for firearm licensing.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 129B of Chapter 140 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, shall be amended by deleting the following in lines 222  
3 through 223: - “Failure to so notify shall be cause for revocation or suspension of such card.”

4 SECTION 2. Section 131 of Chapter 140 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as  
5 appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, shall be amended by deleting the following in lines 306  
6 through 307: - “Failure to so notify shall be cause for revocation or suspension of said license.”
