**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to special education transportation costs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: The fourth sentence of subsection (a) of section 5A of chapter 71B of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the
3 word “not” and said section is further amended by striking, in line 28, the following words: -
4 “transportation costs”
