**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act protecting minor children from medical malpractice.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 260 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 30, after the word “body” the following
3 words:-

4 ; provided, however, that any such action brought on or behalf of an injured party who at
5 the time of the alleged action was a minor child under the age of eighteen shall be commenced
6 within three years of the discovery of the occurrence of the act or omission which is the alleged
7 cause of the injury upon which the action is based, but no later than seven years after the injured
8 party’s twenty-first birthday, whichever is sooner.
