An Act to protect the veterans hiring preference.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2016 official edition, is
2 hereby amended by adding the following section:

3 Section 78

4 Any municipality which seeks to be exempt from the provisions of chapter 31 must
5 submit their hiring policies to the secretary of veteran’s affairs for approval prior to exempting
6 positions from said chapter 31.
