An Act relative to perspective purchasers in manufactured housing communities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision in the laws and regulations of the  
2   Commonwealth to the contrary, in connection with selling a manufactured home in a  
3   Manufactured Housing Community, it is the best interest of all parties that the prospective  
4   purchaser undergoes a financial/criminal background search; and in connection therewith, the  
5   applicant for residency for that Manufactured Housing Community shall be responsible for  
6   reimbursing the owner/operator of that Manufactured Housing Community the actual cost of  
7   acquiring that information.
